

Society of Family Planning Annual Meeting

Call for award nominations

Key dates

- June 8, 2027: Call for award nominations close
- August 2027: Winners are notified

We seek nominations to honor leaders in the field of family planning through four awards:

- **Society of Family Planning Lifetime Achievement Award:** This award is for individuals and/or teams who have spent their careers advancing the science of abortion and contraception, and have supported others in achieving their own success.
- **Society of Family Planning Beacon of Science Award:** This award is reserved for individuals and/or teams who have made marked, visionary contributions towards just and equitable abortion and contraception informed by science. Their work may have included improving clinical care, advancing research, offering education, translating knowledge into policy or practice, or another type of contribution. We place no seniority or disciplinary constraints on nominees for this award, nor do we seek to restrict the types of contributions that can be honored.
- **Society of Family Planning Mentor Award:** This award is for individuals and/or teams who have demonstrated dedication to supporting and furthering the careers of a new generation of academic clinicians or scholars in the field of family planning.
- **Society of Family Planning Next Generation Award:** This award honors individuals early in their careers who have exhibited commitment to the field of family planning through their research or clinical practice. Individuals are eligible to receive this award if they are currently in training or will have completed training in the past five years.

Award details

- Awards will be presented at #SFP2027.
- One person may be invited to interview the award winner.
- Individual award recipients or three representatives from a team award recipient will receive a total cash prize of \$1,000 complimentary conference registration,

up to three nights in the conference hotel, travel up to \$600, a per diem of \$100 per day, a reimbursement of \$100 per day for childcare, will have their membership fees for one year covered.

- Eligible nominees not selected in 2026 will be automatically re-submitted for 2027.

Eligibility

- Nominees must be US-based to reflect our focus on domestic family planning.
- Current members of the [Board of Directors](#) are ineligible.

- Illustrate the impact of the nominee's work and their efforts to advance the [DEI Vision](#), being sure to connect to the specific award criteria, and their impact within family planning.
- Nominations will be reviewed by a selector group made up of prior awardees, members of our Board of Directors, Award Committee members, and members of the family planning community based on the strength of the nominee's contributions to specified award criteria and the strength of the nominee's contribution to advancing the [DEI Vision](#).

 - Please include a brief description (500 words or less) with specific examples of this nominee's contributions.
- Society of Family Planning Beacon of Science Award
 - This award is reserved for individuals and/or teams who have made marked, visionary contributions towards just and equitable abortion and contraception informed by science. Their work may have included improving clinical care, advancing research, offering education, translating knowledge into policy or practice, or another type of contribution. We place no seniority or disciplinary constraints on nominees for this award. Nor do we seek to restrict the types of contributions that can be honored.
 - Questions to consider for the Beacon of Science Award:
 - Please describe the marked, visionary contributions the nominee has made to family planning. In what ways is the nominee an inspiration for all working to advance family planning? You may provide links to showcase the individual or team's work.
 - Please include a brief description (500 words or less) with specific examples of this nominee's contributions.
- Society of Family Planning Mentor Award
 - This award is for individuals and/or teams who have demonstrated dedication to supporting and furthering the careers of a new generation of academic clinicians or scholars in the field of family planning.
 - Questions to consider for the Mentor Award include:
 - How has the nominee demonstrated dedication to mentorship? What has been the impact of their work to support and further the careers of the next generation? You may provide links to showcase the individual or team's work.
 - Please include a brief description (500 words or less) with specific examples of this nominee's contributions.
- Society of Family Planning Next Generation Award
 - This award honors individuals early in their careers who have exhibited commitment to the field of family planning through their research or clinical

practice. Individuals are eligible to receive this award if they are currently in training or will have completed training in the past five years.

- Please include a brief description (500 words or less) with specific examples of this nominee's contributions. Questions to consider for the Next Generation Award include:
 - Is the nominee early in their career and has demonstrated potential to be an emerging leader in the family planning movement? Have they shown creativity, initiative, and commitment to making a difference? You may provide links to showcase the individual or team's work.
 - Confirm that this nominee is currently in training or has completed training in the past five years.
